HOPE FOR THE HOMELESS

PRIMARY CAUSE FOR HOMELESSNESS

LACK OF AFFORDABLE HOUSING

- This is the #1 cause across the nation and especially impactful in Collin County. (Check out *Homelessness is a Housing Problem* by Gregg Colburn)
- \$24.88 is the living wage for an INDIVIDUAL living in Collin County, and this amount only increases based upon household size. (MIT Living Wage Calculator)
- Average 2-bedroom apartment in Collin County is \$1570/mo, which is 18.5% higher than the state average and 9.8% higher than the national average (March 2024 Best Places)
- There are only 25 available units per 100 extremely low-income households in Texas, putting Texas in the top 6 states responsible for the housing crisis (2024 National Low Income Housing Coalition)
- Area landlords are resistant to accept housing vouchers while housed neighbors
 protest based on the stigmas associated with those experiencing homelessness



COLLIN COUNTY HOMELESS 2023

FACTS:

22% of the 516 homeless in the 2023 Collin County count were unsheltered

38% of the 2023 Collin County sheltered count were at the Inn

54% of Inn residents had some degree/certification beyond HS in FY23

48% of Samaritan Inn residents entered the program employed in FY23

THE SHELTER

Applications occur 3 days a week: Sunday, Tuesday, Thursday

- Application process begins at 9am and ends at 1:30pm
 - Adults need
 - government issued photo ID and Social Security card/number
 - Social Security cards and birth certificates for any children
 - Be able to pass a drug test beyond THC usage
 - Be able and willing to work fulltime or part-time if receiving disability
 - Not have a violent offense on their background within the past 10 years

A resident's stay will vary case by case. As long as they are working their program and meeting their goals, their stay could be anywhere from a couple of months to almost two years.



THE SHELTER PROGRAMMING: 4 PILLARS



CASE MANAGEMENT

- The Coach
- Weekly meetings
- They work with them from A-Z with things both in the shelter and outside of it



COUNSELING

- Required
- Can be on-site, off-site, individual or group
- 3 licensed staff, multiple Master's level students



CAREER DEVELOPMENT

- Work Keys certifications and classes
- Resume assistance
- Interviewing skills
- College assistance



FINANCIAL EDUCATION

- Classes: Relationship with Money, Income and Spending, Credit and Debt, Saving and Budgeting
- Budget lab
- One-on-one mentoring





DIVERSION

- A new initiative priority for our Continuum of Care overall in 2024, with only 8 agencies receiving funding for either CAS (Coordinated Access System) or Diversion Case Management
- This new program opens another avenue of services for The Samaritan Inn
- Diversion is the step between prevention and entering the homeless response system for an extended stay
- Implementation this year allows for
 - Increase in services
 - Data gathering for future planning
 - Collaborative opportunities communitywide
